Sarah Cain earned her MFA from the University of California at Berkeley and currently lives in Los Angeles. She uses latex, gouache, acrylic, ink, and spray paint to make bold-colored abstractions in two and three dimensions. A winner of the 2006 SECA Award at the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art, she builds layers of material to connect the practice of painting to sculpture and architecture.
