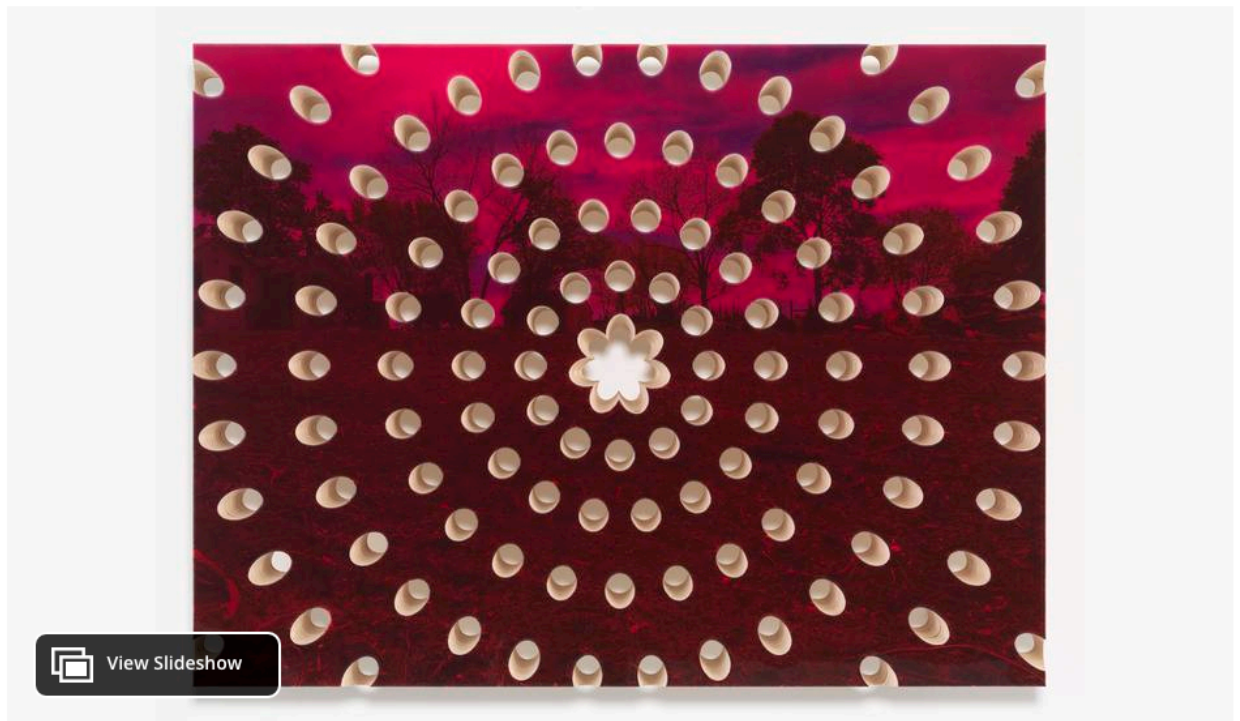

“DONALD MOFFETT: ANY FALLOW FIELD,” a new exhibition by New-York based artist Donald Moffett will run through October 15, 2016, at the two Marianne Boesky gallery locations in New York.

The exhibition features new works by the artist and is his sixth solo show with the gallery. The artworks on display are inspired by the disregard that humans have for nature this, broadening Moffett's ongoing engagement with the body politic. The exhibition is the first show dedicated to a single artist to be presented in the gallery's recently expanded Chelsea location, across both 507 and 509 West 24th Street. "Any fallow field" includes Moffett's latest extruded paintings, contemplating the natural world. With these signature works, the artist uses his oil paint into individual projections that are perpendicular to the canvas.

The exhibition is on view at Marianne Boesky Gallery, 509 West 24th Street, New York, NY 10011, and Boesky East, 507 West 24th Street, New York, NY 10011.
