JJ Peet's "OSVRX" is an internal reference to language, coding and embedded meaning. The debut exhibition at the gallery highlights a suite of cast bronze sculptures as well as a selection of paintings on panel. All of the paintings in the exhibition share the rough-hewn technique of the artist's sculptures but fall within a more formal order. They have been created in a series of steps, with surfaces layered one over another, often taking information from mistakes or happenstance. These works further investigate the connection between sight and mind; the thin line between viewing and being viewed. As a result, works have a multi-faceted, layered approach that is aesthetically raw and purposefully unpolished, belying the elegant and precise decision making processes by which works are created.

JJ Peet currently lives and works in Brooklyn, and has received a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from the University of Minnesota, Minneapolis, MN in 1999 along with a Master of Fine Arts degree from Yale School of Art, New Haven, CT in 2006. The artist was also the recipient of the 1998 NCECA Student Fellowship; the 1998-99 Brown McKenzie, Scholarship University of Minnesota, MN; the 1999-00 Resident Artist, Anderson Ranch Arts Center, Snowmass Village, CO; and the 2014 Resident Artist, Anderson Ranch Arts Center, Snowmass Village, CO. Some of the recent group exhibitions include Richard Shaw and JJ PEET, Harvey / Meadows Gallery, Aspen, CO, 2016; Satan Ceramics, Ever Gold Gallery, San Francisco, CA, 2016; Live in the layers...not on the litter, Ashley Berlin, Berlin, Germany, 2015 and others.
