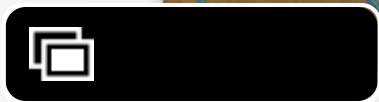
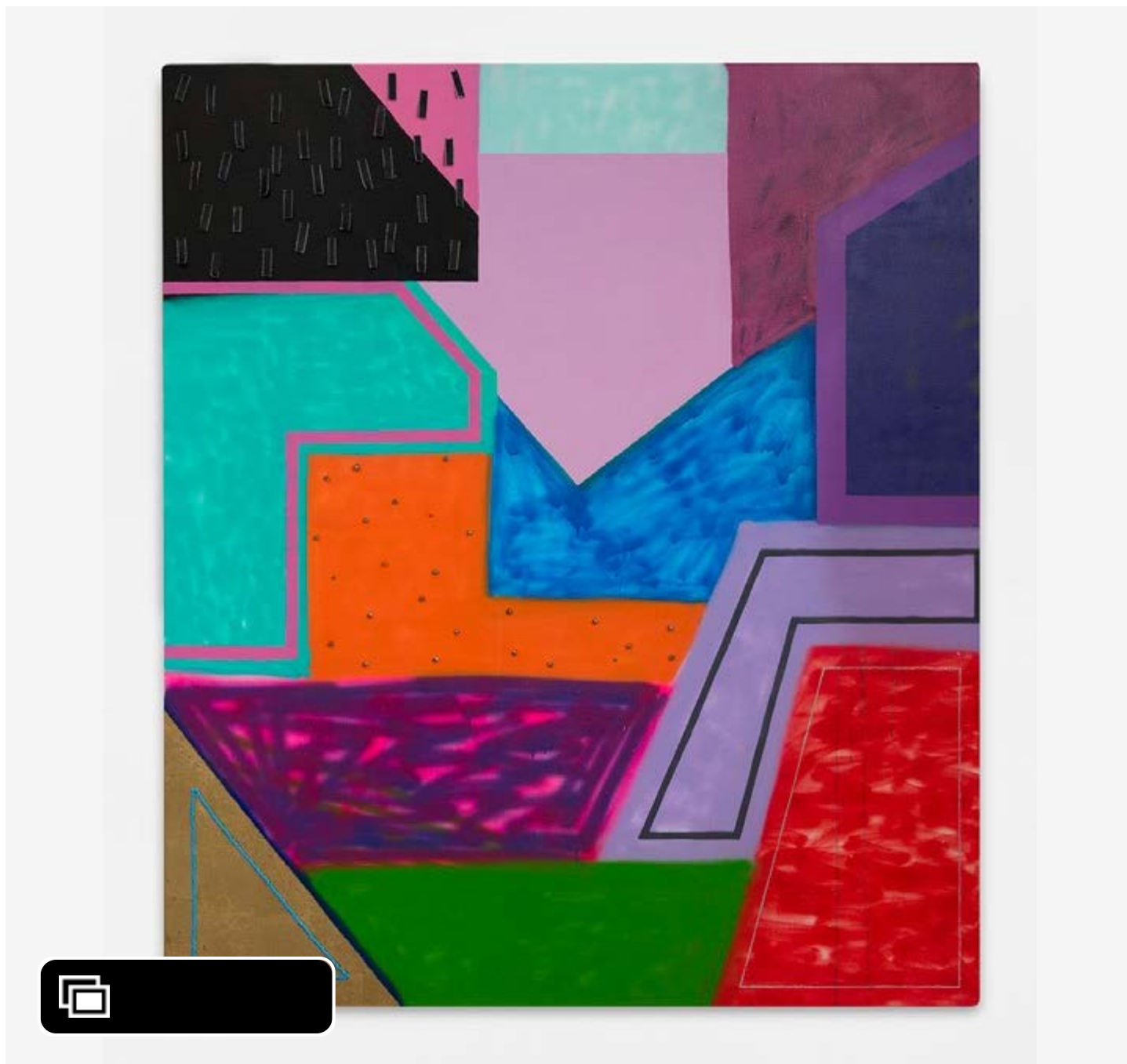

New York artist [Sarah Cain](#) is soon to open her first ever London exhibition. “Wild Flower” is the title of the contemporary artist’s latest body of work, which features multiple styles of art. The Timothy Taylor gallery will open its doors to the solo show on April 18, 2018.

[Sarah Cain](#) is well known for her innovative ideas with depth of color, line and shape, using diverse styles such as Abstract Expressionism, graffiti and Pop Art. Her paintings and installations employ a variety of materials including unusual and poetic artefacts like musical notations, leaves and branches to extend beyond the canvas, encompassing the surrounding environment, creating many site-specific installations. This exhibition showcases the philosophy of the artist with a range of paintings, and a large site-specific work, which the artist will paint directly onto the gallery wall.

In this exhibition, Sarah Cain relates the fortitude of uncultivated plants and their tendency to flourish in the harshest environment to her unusual approach and “renegade” technique to the medium of painting and abstraction. Her works often extend from the plane of the canvas into three-dimensional space through the addition of seashells, chains, tassels, and found objects.

Sarah Cain was born in Albany, New York, in 1979. She lives and works in Los Angeles. She was awarded BFA from the San Francisco Art Institute and MFA from the University of California at Berkeley. Her work has been showcased in numerous solo exhibitions including at Institute of Contemporary Art, Los Angeles; Aspen Art Museum ; Anthony Meier Fine Arts, San Francisco; Galerie Lelong, New York; Contemporary Art Museum Raleigh; Museum of Contemporary Art San Diego; and Honor Fraser, Los Angeles.

“Wild Flower” will run from April 18 through May 25, 2018, at Timothy London, 15 Carlos Pl, Mayfair, London W1K 2EX, UK.
