

Zoe Leonard's "Analogue" West Coast Debut at Hauser & Wirth, Los Angeles

Hauser & Wirth, Los Angeles, will host the West Coast debut of American artist [Zoe Leonard](#)'s decade-long project, "Analogue." The show opens on October 27, 2018.

"Analogue" coincides with The Museum of Contemporary Art, Los Angeles (MOCA) retrospective – "[Zoe Leonard. Survey.](#)" This is the gallery's first Los Angeles exhibition dedicated to the New York-based artist.

"Analogue" (1998 - 2009) is a landmark, decade-long project. It is made up of 412 photographs documenting the homogenizing effects of globalization. The installation features photographs of vanishing storefronts and abandoned objects. Leonard captured this using a vintage 1940s Rolleiflex camera which in itself is an obsolete technology along with gelatin silver and chromogenic processes.

"A pre-eminent artist of her generation, Leonard balances rigorous conceptualism with a distinctly personal vision in her work, which encourages the viewer to reconsider the act of looking," a press note on the Gallery website states. This is the West Coast debut of Leonard's monumental installation, which was first shown in 2007 at The Wexner Center for the Arts, Columbus OH.

Zoe Leonard (b.1961) is an American artist who works with photography, sculpture, and installation. The artist garnered international acclaim for her installation at Documenta IX in 1992. She has been exhibition since the late 1980s. Her recent solo exhibitions include Whitney Museum of American Art, "Zoe Leonard: Survey," New York NY; Galerie Gisela Captain, "Zoe Leonard," Cologne, Germany; Hauser & Wirth, "In the Wake," New York NY; and Museum of Modern Art, "Analogue," New York NY, among others. Leonard lives and works in New York.

The exhibition opens on October 27, and runs through January 20, 2019, at Hauser & Wirth, 901 East 3rd Street, Los Angeles CA 90013.
